Field name	Format	Description
<b>year</b>	Number	Year in which indicators were recorded. Currently includes 2009-2014.
<b>county</b>	Plain text	County in which jurisdiction is located.
<b>agency_name</b>	Plain text	Law enforcement agency/jurisdiction name. 'All Combined' stands for county.
<b>agency_code</b>	Plain text	Law enforcement jurisdiction code. 'All Combined' stands for county.
<b>less_than_high_school</b>	Percent	Percentage of population with educational attainment less than high school.
<b>high_school_or_higher</b>	Percent	Percentage of population with educational attainment of high school or higher.
<b>bachelors_or_higher</b>	Percent	Percentage of population with educational attainment of bachelors degree or higher.
<b>per_capita_income</b>	Number	Per capita Income (in inflation adjusted dollars for the particular year)
<b>median_household_income_2014_dollars</b>	Number	Median household annual income in (inflation adjusted dollars for the particular year)
<b>poverty_rate</b>	Percent	Percentage of population below the poverty rate
<b>employment_rate</b>	Percent	Percentage of the working-age population (ages 16 and over) that is employed
<b>unemployment_rate</b>	Percent	Percentage of the total labor force that is unemployed but actively seeking employment and willing to work
